



Grant funding disclosure, 2017/18

We think it's important that accreditation standards, think tanks and public policy campaigns should be open and honest as to their sources of grant funding.

The majority of the Fair Tax Mark's income is derived from trading activity and the assessment and licensing of business to our accreditation standards. This amounted to £68,166 in 2017, as detailed in our Financial Statements.

In addition, we received and expended the following grant support in 2017:

- Joseph Rowntree Charitable Trust (£33,750). Supported our core mission of increasing the number of Fair Tax Mark certified businesses, not least via promotion of the Mark and the ongoing development of standards.
- Network for Social Change (£5,432). Supported the analysis of Tax Strategy reporting among the FTSE's fifty largest companies, and the ensuing report that was released in October 2017.
